Local Roadway & Connector Alternatives to be Presented at BLRA’s June 19 Meeting

*Description of Each Alternative, Schematics & Public Comment

City of Bayonne, NJ, June 12, 2003 – Today, the Bayonne Local Redevelopment Authority (“BLRA”) announced that three (3) local roadway and connector alternatives, developed during the first three months of the Peninsula at Bayonne Harbor Land Use and Transportation Study, will be presented during the BLRA’s June 19th Board Meeting and available for review and comment on the City of Bayonne’s website.

According to Nancy Kist, Executive Director, BLRA, “In April 2003, the BLRA initiated a comprehensive Land Use and Transportation Study. As part of this study, the North Jersey Transportation Authority (“NJTPA”) funded a Local Roadway and Connector study to identify possible roadway and connector alternatives that would connect the City of Bayonne to the Peninsula at Bayonne Harbor in the most efficient way possible.”

The purpose of Local Roadway and Connector study is to develop a conceptual plan that links the Peninsula at Bayonne Harbor to the City of Bayonne and the regional roadway network. The BLRA’s consultant team developed a number of roadway improvement alternatives following a comprehensive review and assessment of existing studies, field investigations, traffic counts (i.e. automated and manual), land use and development data and aerial photographs. As a result, an extensive list of conceptual roadway improvements alternatives was developed. This list of alternatives was subjected to a fatal flaw analysis to dismiss alternatives that were considered not to be feasible or acceptable to the local community. Three (3) alternatives survived this process.

“The three (3) alternatives which have survived the internal process will now be presented to the BLRA Board of Commissioners at City Hall on the evening of June 19, 2003,” added Kist. “In addition, on or about June 19, 2003, these roadway and connector alternatives will be posted on the BLRA page of the City of Bayonne’s website - www.bayonnenj.org/blra. Comments will be accepted in writing and through the website via email.”
